On July 1, 1943 the 464th Bombardment Group (H), consisting of the 776th, 777th, 778th, and 779th Bomb Sqdns, was activated at Wendover Field, Utah, on authority of G.O. No. 78 Par 1, Section 1, Hq, 2nd Air Force, dated 29 May 1943, which quoted WD letter AG 322 (5-18-43) OB-I-AFRPGM, 19 May 1943, Subject: "Constitution and Activation of Certain Army Air Forces Units" as its authority. In above order we find the following information concerning this group: Wendover Field, Utah, is designated its permanent station; T.O. 1-112, dated 26 March 1943 and T.O. 1-117, dated 26 March 1943 is to be used as a guide in the organization of the unit; the Group is to reach 25% strength on 1 September 1943, 50% strength on 1 October 1943 and 100% on 25 October 1943.

On 22 August 1943 the 464th Bomb Gp made its first temporary change of station by moving without personnel or equipment to AAB, Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho, in compliance with Letter File 370.5G, Subject: Movement of Unit: 464th Bomb Gp (H), Hq, 2nd Air Force, dated 22 August 1943.

It was not until 26 August 1943 that personnel were first assigned to the units of this group. In preparation for this assignment, Lt. Col. HENRY K. SEAL, O-102398, then executive of AAB, Pocatello, Idaho, was transferred to the Parent Group, 29th Bomb Gp, to make preparations for the incoming personnel.

Par 2, S.O. No. 238 Hq, AAB, Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho, dated 26 August 1943, assigned the first personnel to the group. Key personnel as outlined by this order are as follows:

Par 3 and 14, S.O. No. 239 Hq, Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho, dated 27 August 1943 ordered a cadre of 33 officers and 67 enlisted men, on DS at A.A.F.S.A.T. Orlando, Fla for thirty days. This cadre departed from Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho on 28 August 1943 and arrived at A.A.F.S.A.T. Orlando Fla on 2 September 1943.

Lt Colonel MARSHALL (NMI) BONNER, O-18967, AC, joined the group at A.A.F.S.A.T. Orlando Fla on 2 September 1943 pursuant to authority contained in Par 17, S.O. No 244, Hq, AAB, Biggs Field, Texas (Auth: TWX 2AT A-4542-G, Colo Springs, Colo) and assumed command per G.O. No 1, Hq, 464th Bomb Gp (H), AAF, Orlando, Fla on 2 September 1943.

Lt Colonel SYLVAN D. HAND, O-22807, AC, reported for duty as Deputy Group Commander at Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho on 19 Sept 43 pursuant to auth contained in Par 9, S.O. No 260 Hq, BTC #5, AAF West Tech Trng Comd, Kearns, Utah 17 Sept 43 (Auth: telegram 15 BW S555C, CC, 15th Bomb Wg, AAB, Gowen Fld, Boise, Idaho).

The first decoration in the group was presented to Sgt Harry A. Bruneau, 12033129, of the 779th Bomb Sq (H) on Sunday 23 Oct 43. The award was made by Lt Col BONNER during the parade and review commemorating the 1st anniversary of the Pocatello AAB. The Legion of Merit was awarded Sgt Bruneau for service in the Guadalcanal campaign for meritorious service, initiative and devotion to duty in maintaining combat aircraft.

On Tuesday, September 21, the entire portion of the command, then stationed at Gowen Field, held a picnic in one of the canyons leading up out of Boise.

The afternoon was devoted to athletic events, there being several ball games; fishing, swimming, and mountain climbing.

Before returning to camp, practically all those present were driven up in trucks to see the famous Arrow Rock Dam and Reservoir, one of the well-known engineering pieces of construction in the West.

Paras 38, 39, and 40, S.O.No. 267 Hq, A.A.F.S.A.T, Orlando, Fla transferred the cadre at that station to Army Air Base, Pocatello, Idaho. The cadre departed from Pine Castle Air Base, Pine Castle, Fla on 25 September 1943 arriving at new station on 30 September 43.

The detachment remaining at Gowen Field, Boise Idaho were transferred to AAB, Pocatello, Idaho pursuant to authority contained in Par 1, S.O. No. 274, Hq, Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho 1 October 1943, departing that station on 2 October 1943 arriving at AAB, Pocatello, Idaho 2 October 1943.

During the period spent at AAFSAT, Orlando, Fla four B-24E Aircraft were assigned to the group to be used for training purposes. These aircraft were transferred with the group to AAB, Pocatello, Idaho. On arrival at that station three of the Aircraft were reassigned to another group. During the month of October, three B-24 aircraft were assigned, giving the group a total of four B-24 aircraft for training purposes as of 31 October 1943.

The first casualty in the group was 1st Sgt Ernest F. Norman, 6289084, of the 779th Bomb Sq (H). Sgt Norman entered the service on 2 May 1939 and death occurred on the 24th October 1943. Death was in the line of duty and caused by generalized peritonitis, acute, due to acute suppurative appendicitis; complicated by broncho pneumonia.

Personnel strength of the group as of 31 October 1943 as follows:
Percentage of authorized strength -- Officers, 18%; Enlisted Men, 35%;
total officers and enlisted men -- 31 7/10%.
