ORGANIZATION - PERSONNEL - BIOGRAPHIES - PICTURES

On 7 December 1943 the 308th Airdrome Squadron was attached to the group for training purposes only. (1)

The first combat crew personnel were received from 15th Bombardment Operational Training Wing station as follows: 20 crews from Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho--10 crews being assigned 7 November 1943 and 10 crews being assigned 10 November 1943, (2)(3)(4) these crews were former anti-submarine patrol crews with many hours of flying to their credit. Ground personnel assignments from 18th Replacement Wing were heavy during the period covered. The total strength of the group was 260 officers and 1347 enlisted men as of 30 November 1943, and 403 officers and 1604 enlisted men as of 31 December 1943.

Owing to the hospitalization of our group S-4, Capt C. W. Collins was replaced on 20 December 1943 by 1st Lt Peter Ceccato. (5)

A change in commanding officers of the 779th Squadron was effected on 21 December 1943, Major Elvin E. Goodyear assuming command in place of Capt Arthur (NMI) Hampson. (6)

Shortages of certain technicians during this period considerably hampered maintenance and training.

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Some reclassification was necessary due to directives received changing MOS numbers of certain personnel and also due to improper classification in some instances. Grades and classifications made necessary some of the adjustment.

BIOGRAPHIES

Lt Col Marshall Bonner, group commanding officer, graduated from the U. S. Military Academy in 1933 and from Kelly Field in 1934. He is rated a senior pilot, combat observer, and aircraft observer. He also served for several years as an instructor at the U.S. Military Academy.

Lt Col Sylvan D. Hand, deputy group commander, is a graduate of Kelly Field and has ten (10) years service in the Army, twenty-nine (29) months service in the Caribbean.

Lt Col Henry Kendall Seal, group executive officer, is a veteran of World War I, having served overseas with the Field Artillery with the rank of Major.

Capt Weldon K. Burton, group S-3, is a former member of the R.C.A.F. A civilian flyer he joined the R.C.A.F. on 10 February 1941 as an instructor pilot and accepted a commission in the A.A.F. when the United States entered the war.

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1st Lt Peter Ceccato recently assigned group S-4 has twenty-eight years in the Army, twenty-four years being in the Air Corps. The knowledge of maintenance and supply problems and solutions he has acquired in these years has already proven highly beneficial in training and should be an effective addition to our combat capabilities.

Major Thomas J. Carter, Commanding Officer of the 777th Squadron, promoted to Major from Captain 23 December 1943*, started his career in the Army as a flying cadet on 9 February 1940 at Randolph Field, Texas. He graduated from Kelly Field in October 1940 and was selected as an instructor in which capacity he served for two years at Randolph Field, Texas. Preparation for heavy bombardment was at AAB, Fort Worth, Texas and as instructor-pilot at Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho. He was among the first personnel assigned to the group.

Major Elvin E. Goodyear, Commanding Officer of the 779th Squadron graduated from Kelly Field in October 1940 and was assigned as instructor-pilot at Barksdale Field, Shreveport, Louisiana; then served in similar capacity at Craig Field, Selma, Alabama, and Napier Field, Dothan, Alabama, and prepared for his heavy bombardment assignment at Columbus, Ohio. Major Goodyear had three years of R.O.T.C. training before joining the ranks of aviation cadets.

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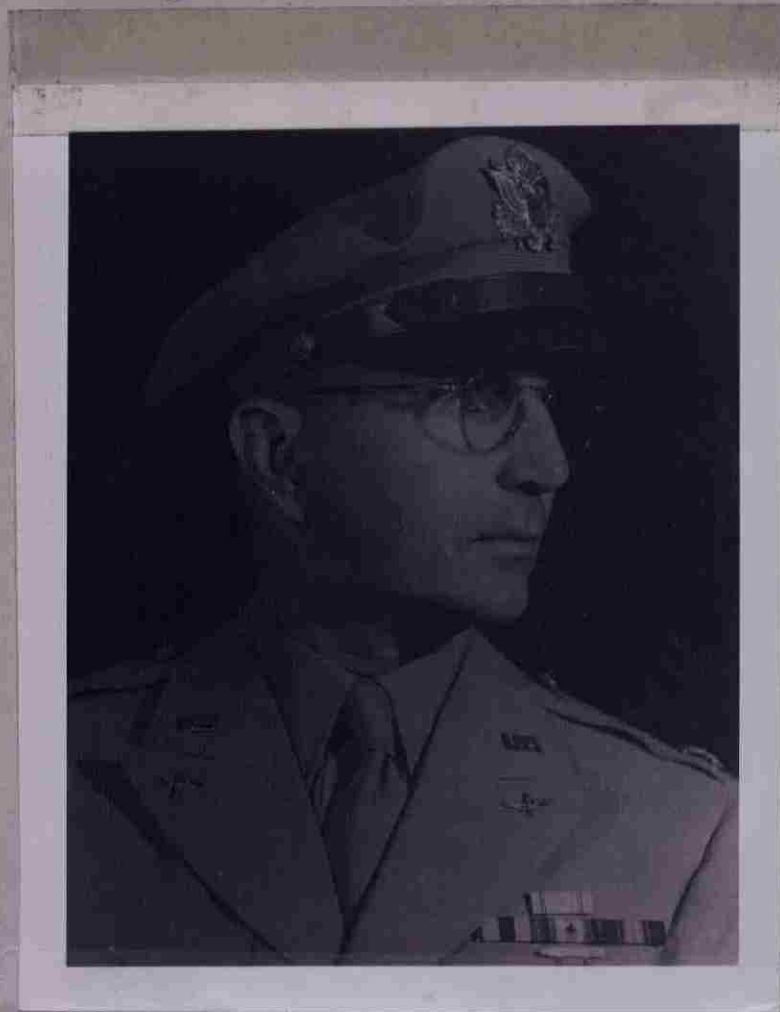

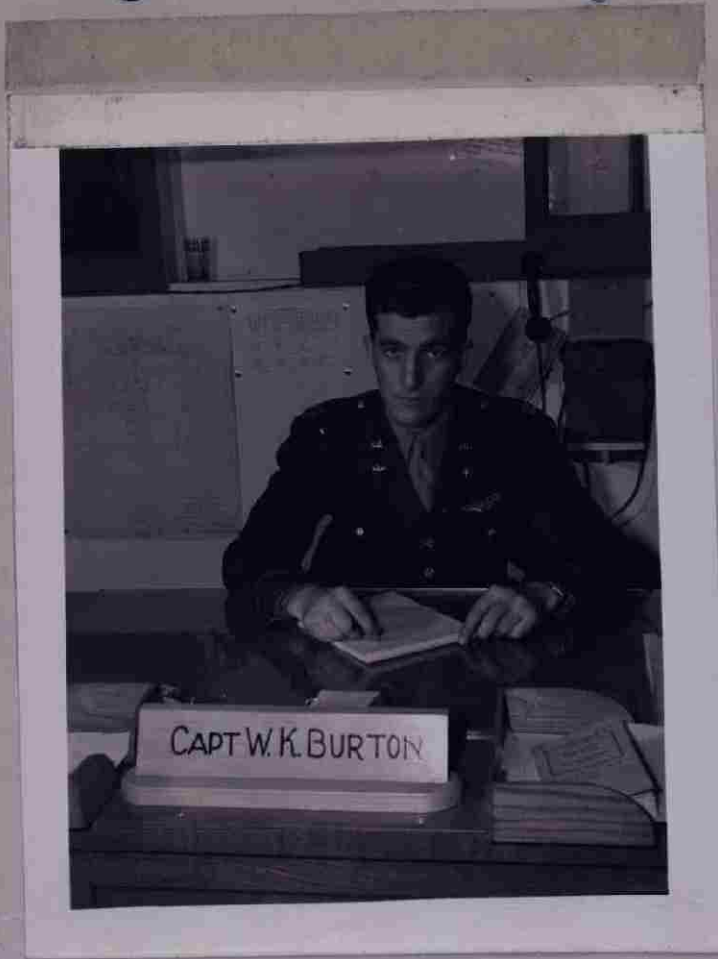

SUPPLY AND EQUIPMENT

Supply and equipment have been excellent and the efficiency of the base and sub depot personnel has assisted greatly in the accomplishment of training.

MAINTENANCE

Specific maintenance problems encountered have been ordinary problems and the progress in solving them has been satisfactory.

There has been no new maintenance procedures adopted.

As yet, there has been no outstanding maintenance jobs to do; all maintenance jobs have been routine.

The specific percentages of airplanes in commission and flyable on 24 hour basis were: for the month of November, 52%; for the month of December, 60%. Average total for the two months combined is 56%.

MORALE

Morale during the last of November and first part of December was below standard. Certain assigned combat crew members who had considerable flying experience and considerable service felt they were not given proper consideration. An analysis of the situation by the commanding officer resulted in the recommendation for promotion of some of the officers concerned, transfer of some copilots to other organizations where there were openings for first pilots, and other reassignments within the group. No disciplinary action was necessary and morale at the end of the period was excellent.

TRAINING

The first combat crews--former anti-submarine patrol personnel and seasoned four engine aircraft operators--assigned to the group from Gowen Field, Boise, Idaho, on 7 and 10 November 1943, had need for high altitude formation flying and bombing and further development of gunnery and radio technique. (2)(3)(4) Second phase training was started immediately upon their arrival and by 30 November 1943 they had completed about 60% of the second phase requirements.

An additional fifteen crews--assigned from Casper, Wyoming, 14 being assigned on 16 November 1943 and 1 being assigned on 23 November 1943--had completed all three phases and the personnel were assigned as instructors and assistants to the squadron section heads to assist in training and further their own training. (15)(16)(17)(18) Gunners and radio operators continued with their ground training in their primary duties and engineers were assigned to work on the line to further their knowledge in practical maintenance.

18 crews were assigned on 2 December 1943 and 18 more crews were assigned on 4 December 1943, both assignments being made from Army Air Base, Mountain Home, Idaho, after having completed first phase training at that base. (19)(20) Second phase flying and ground training was started for this group on 8 December 1943. At this point the group had 37 airplanes and the first 24 crews having completed second phase on 18 December 1943 were given leave until 31 December 1943.

During this period all second phase ground school was completed and as of 31 December 1943 flying training was as follows: 15 crews completed three phases before reporting and were accomplishing continuous training in their primary duties; 24 crews had completed second phase ground and flying training and were just returning from leave ready to start third phase; 36 crews had completed second phase ground school and 66 2/3% of second phase flying training.

The efficiency of 39 crews was above average due in large part to their previous experience and the additional opportunity for further training. 36 crews were considered as satisfactory and showing the necessary progress.

Training was as of 31 December 1943 abreast of schedule in ground training and about 10 days behind schedule as pertains to 36 crews flying training.

Training was delayed during December by adverse weather conditions, maintenance difficulties such as extremely cold weather hampering maintenance crews, and in a good many cases not in stock parts resulted in out of commission planes when weather was good and crews available to fly. Training airplanes received were often in bad condition requiring major repairs before putting in service and many flying training hours were lost as a result of this condition. One accident on 19 December 1943 resulting from possible carburetor icing or probable practice of less than four engine operation resulted in the total

destruction of airplane #427074 and the loss of eight crew members.

Two crew members survived, one successfully bailing out and the other not on the flight as he was grounded for medical reasons. A roster of the crew indicating the survivors is inclosed. (21)

It being evident completion of all model missions could not be accomplished, higher headquarters directed that flying training be concentrated on the most missions. Ground training was changed on 20 December 1943 to conform to the new Second Air Force Technical Training Program.
